In which case the **SiLC Affiliate Scheme** is for you. It assists new graduates, as well as more experienced individuals, to work towards full membership and chartered status of a professional body with the assistance of a professional body adviser, and then progress towards SiLC/SQP registration with the assistance of a SiLC mentor. The scheme can be entered at any level. The aim is to provide an integrated process for those on the scheme through chartership and SiLC/SQP

registration with clear objectives utilising the National Brownfield Skills Framework and an early understanding of the purpose and benefits including CPD, the NQMS and the role of an SQP.

An application guide which explains more about the SiLC Affiliate Scheme and an application form are available to download from the SiLC website ([www.silc.org.uk](http://www.silc.org.uk)). Members of the scheme will be designated as SiLC Affiliates, each with a

SiLC Affiliate number, thereby demonstrating an individual's commitment to becoming chartered and, in due course, a SiLC. The annual membership cost of the SiLC Affiliate Scheme is £50 plus VAT. This fee includes 20% discount on the attendance fee for the SiLC Annual Forum.

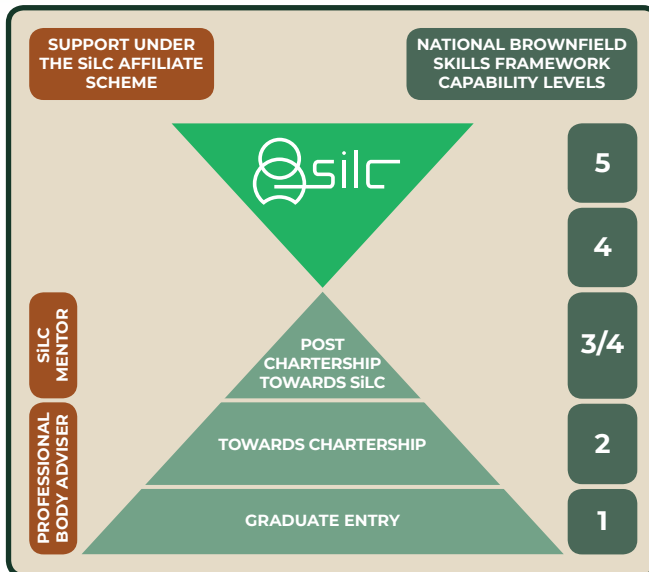




## National Brownfield Skills Framework (NBSF)

A copy of the NBSF can be found on the SiLC website. It defines the capabilities pertinent to those operating within the brownfield, reclamation and regeneration industry and promotes development of capability by engaging individuals and organisations in proactive and progressive skills development. These capabilities are pertinent to all those working in the industry, encompassing private and public sector.

The figure below shows the relationship between the tiers leading to chartership and then to SiLC registration under the SiLC Affiliate Scheme and the capability levels of the NBSF. The support under the SiLC Affiliate Scheme is also shown.
